Junior Players

AS A TEAM MEMBER

- Compete by the competition conditions and rules
- Never argue with the decision of the Umpire or Official
- Control temper: no criticism by word/gesture, obscene language will not be tolerated
- Work equally for yourself and your team your team's performance will benefit and so will your own
- · Keeping of late hours will detract from your own and your team's performance
- Be a good sport, Encourage and support your team mates
- · Co-operate with your coach and team mates. Show respect for your opponents and their skills
- Be friendly to all participants
- Smoking, drinking of alcohol or the taking of non-prescribed drugs is strictly forbidden
- Entering and remaining on licensed premises unless under the supervision of the team's officials is strictly forbidden
- For the duration of the tournament, **under no circumstances**, transport other team members in private vehicles without the permission of the team officials **and** member's parents

AS A GUEST

- Keep your room tidy and make your bed respect the property of motel/accommodation. YOU/YOUR PARENTS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PAYMENT OF ANY DAMAGES TO YOUR ROOM
- Assist manager by following instructions and being respectful at all times. Assist him/her where possible with "household" chores, preparing meals/washing uniforms etc
- Be courteous at all times, and say THANK YOU often
- Advise your manager/coach when and where you will be whilst not playing. They are responsible for the whole team and co-operation with them is essential
- If delayed unexpectedly, contact your manager/coach immediately
- Social activities other than those organized or approved by team managers or host centres are not permitted
- Pay for phone calls as you make them (motel phone calls can be expensive) do not borrow money. See Team Manager if you have problems
- Respect the wishes and routine of your room mates
- Be responsible you are representing your city and Maryborough Hockey. Ensure that you look after your own property (ensure everything is clearly marked). This is your responsibility
- Do not consume alcohol, smoke or take non-prescribed drugs
